Class Descriptions:

Please consult the instructor for proper level placement.

Dance Exploration (3-4): a myriad of movement and manipulations to give the children an opportunity to express themselves in movement. The framework of story, song and props is used to teach the very basics of ballet, gracefulness and following directions.

Pre-Ballet (5-6): a joyous introduction and/or continuation of the freedom of movement within structure - drawing from the heart while training the body and mind - establishing a working ballet vocabulary through repetition, story, song and choreography.

Ballet I & II: a firm foundation from which to dance - ballet technique using discipline, repetition, and inspirational music in order to develop grace, poise and body control through which the heart is free to dance.

Ballet III: Building upon a foundational skill set from Ballet II, this class will shape good form and increase one's dance vocabulary; confidence and knowledge of one's body deepens as one gains strength, flexibility, and skill. Movement becomes increasingly purposed and meaningful - and always as an expression of the heart.

Contemporary Modern Beginner: an introduction to modern dance incorporating the fundamentals of ballet for strength and beauty. A liberated dance form saturated with feeling. Dance experience beneficial but not required.

Musical Theatre Dance (preteen/teen): Centered on storytelling and extraordinary expression, this class invites dancers/actors/actresses who want to focus on really "moving" a story. Selections from musicals as well as story set to music will inspire the dance. Basic technique will be incorporated in the warm-up. Dance experience beneficial but not required. A great class for actors/actresses.
